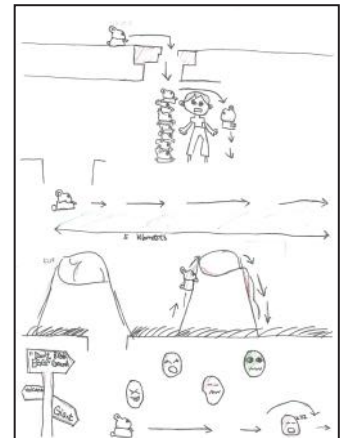

The lights were normal in the cellar where I landed, and I could see. There was a room and it looked like a dining room. There was a wizard. He said,

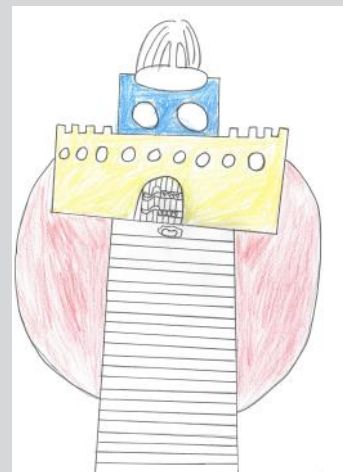

Once upon a time, there was a boy named Clement. He had a bad day, the very worst day.

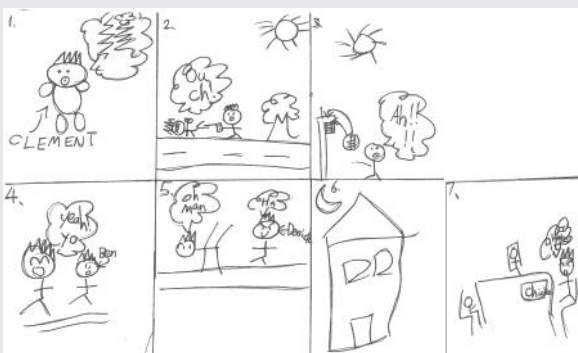

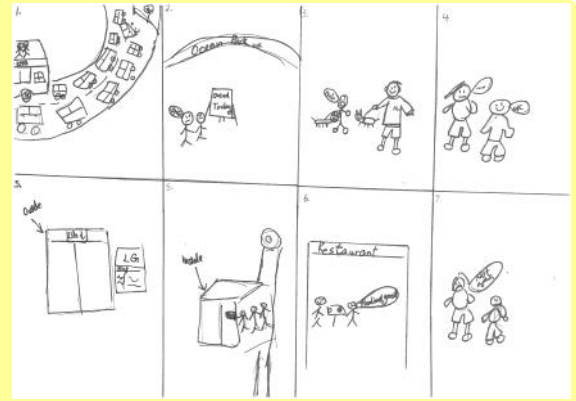
He thought, "I want to play with Thomas." Thomas came to his house. They played
