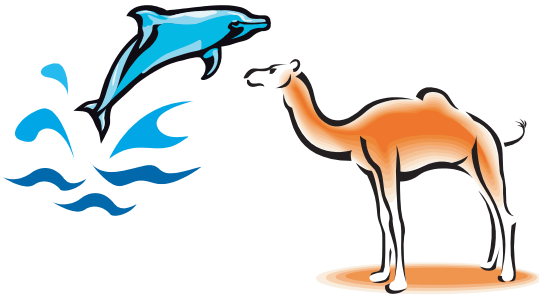

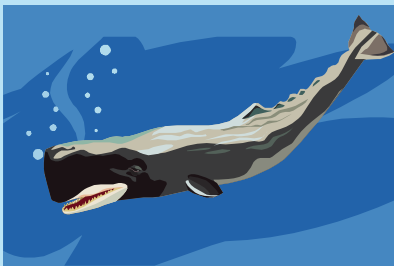


Super Safe Firemen on the Sea

Luby the Dolphin Princess

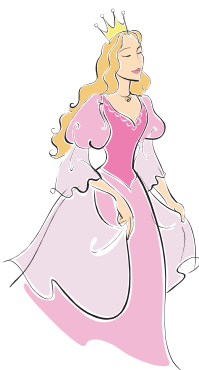

Next, I am very clever but the pig is very silly. He is so silly. I have seen him step on food and eat things that are

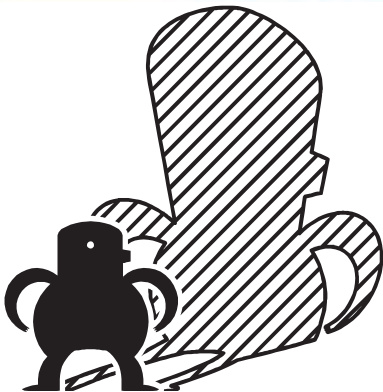
dirty or that taste bad! I never step on

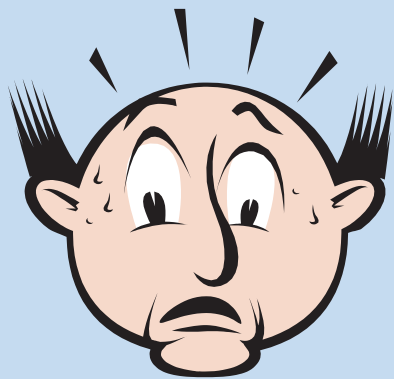
When I was in a hotel,

It was very bad.



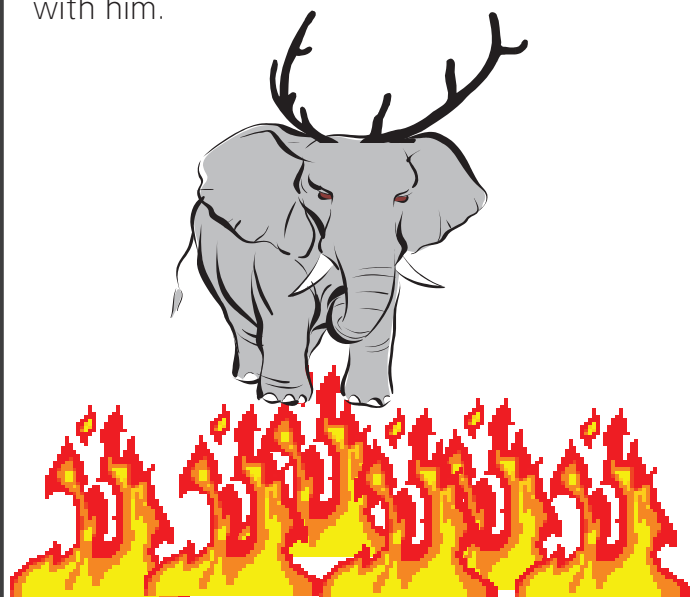
Giants

fish.

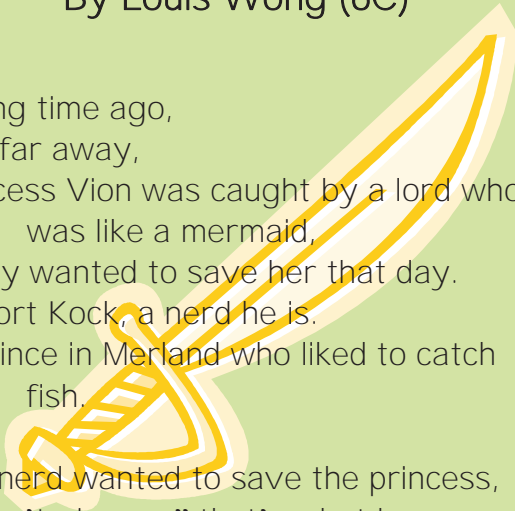
The nerd wanted to save the princess,
