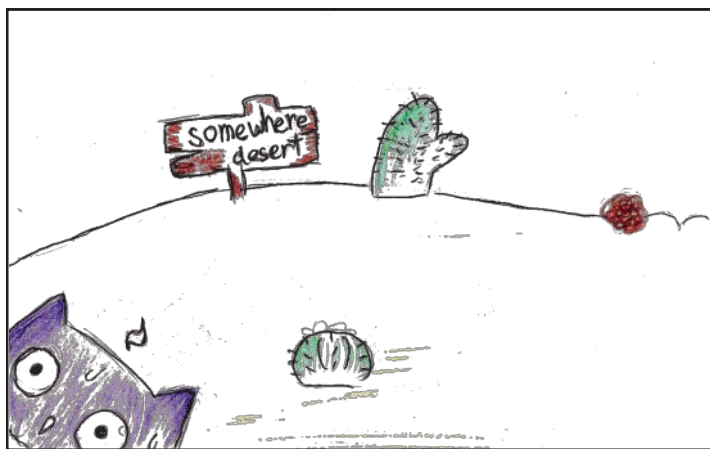
Dear Wife (and Baby),

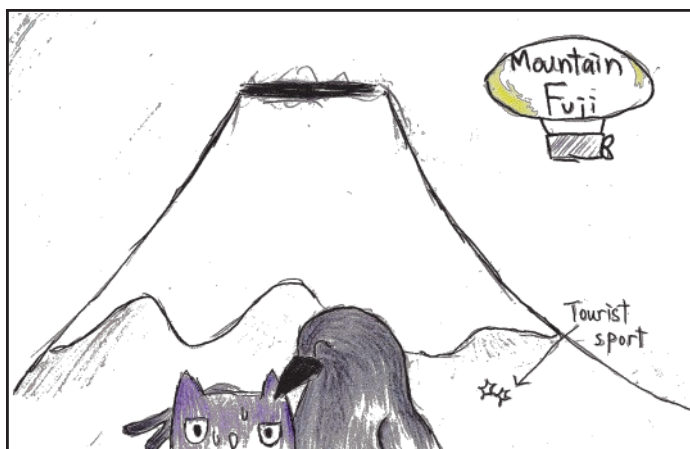
Dear, dear Wife and Baby,
