
The English Buddy videos teach the students English. Most of the students strongly agree that the English Buddy videos on Lee Kam TV are great.




The food ingredient cards shows us what food the students eat in their lunch. Most of the students read the food ingredients cards in the canteen.


Miss Karen and the English Buddies play many pop songs once a month. The music is played through speakers after school. Most of the students enjoy listening to the English songs before school and when they leave school.


Over all, we see most of the students like the activities by the English DJs and Miss Karen.











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
